

Hoosiers will be required to wear masks beginning July 27



- Applies to anyone 8 years or older in indoor public spaces, commercial entities or transportation services, or in outside public spaces when you cannot socially distance
- Mask use in schools required for grades 3 and up, faculty and staff, volunteers and anyone else in schools
 - Masks are also required for co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, with exceptions for strenuous physical activity
- Exceptions will be made for medical purposes, strenuous physical activity, eating and drinking
- Masks are strongly recommended for ages 2 7

Hoosiers will be required to wear masks beginning July 27



Determining factors:

- Get children back to school and keep Indiana businesses open and operating
- Increase in COVID-19 positivity rate
- Increase in number of Hoosiers hospitalized for COVID-19
- Additional counties seeing more cases
- Increase in cases and positivity rates in neighboring states
